**THIS IS YOUR CHANCE TO STOP THE RANDOM LISTING OF OUR
LOVED ONES' NAMES AT THE MEMORIAL**

Dear Families:

The LMDC is going forward with random listing of names throughout the Memorial along with badges following the names of Firefighters, and Police Officers. When polled, you responded that this plan did not meet your needs. In response, many Family group leaders met to come up with an acceptable alternative. While no compromise is ever perfect, we believe we have found a solution, and we would like your support. Our alternative to random listing in no way, addresses, or detracts from the proposal to place pictures of our loved ones on the tomb for the remains; you can support both proposals.

The Families' Proposal: **Remembering People's Lives, Not Only Names**, is as follows:

- Every person will be listed under his or her appropriate affiliation heading.
- People associated with a particular Tower will have their names listed in the representative footprint of that Tower, in alphabetical order followed by their age and the floor on which they worked.
- Persons not associated with a particular tower will be listed by affiliation in an alternate, equally important space within the Memorial. Uniformed rescue workers will be listed together by unit and rank rather than randomly with an insignia. Airlines will be designated by flight, and listed in alphabetical order, with crewmember's names preceded by their rank. Civilians will be listed in alphabetical order. Those people without an affiliation or who do not wish to be listed with their affiliation will be listed together in the chosen alternate space.

EXAMPLES of the Families' Proposal follow (names, ages, floors, and affiliations are fictitious and for example purposes only):
